OSHA Recordkeeping Course

High Safety Consulting Services, Ltd. will offer an OSHA Recordkeeping Course on May 22, 2006 at our facility in Lancaster, PA from 8:00 AM to 12:00 Noon.

OSHA's rule addressing the recording and reporting of occupational injuries and illnesses affects approximately 1.3 million establishments. Most establishments with more than 10 employees must maintain injury records for OSHA. In my compliance reviews I almost ALWAYS find recordkeeping mistakes! I recently read an article in a trade publication that gave incorrect guidance on OSHA recordkeeping.

If you are responsible for maintaining the OSHA Log or overseeing those that do, this course is for YOU! This program will review how to use and complete the forms correctly. We will discuss all those "sticky" questions including commuting, medical treatment interpretations, significant diagnosis interpretations, how to count lost-time or restricted days, prescription questions, and we will review how to calculate incident rates properly for your company. Participants will have the opportunity to use the Log for a number of cases to develop expertise in its application.

As an extra bonus, we will review other safety recordkeeping documents your company may be required to have. You will receive a manual with the rule and specific guidance materials which will serve as a ready reference for all your OSHA log questions!
